

Grays Point PS 2010 Annual Swimming Carnival

- FOR:** Students in Years 3-6. All swimming abilities are catered for including activities in beginners pool so ALL students are expected to attend and participate for their House. All family and friends are very welcome to come and support the children. Spectators will be charged \$1.70 for pool entry.
- WHEN:** Wednesday 17th February
- WHERE:** Engadine Leisure Centre, Anzac Avenue, Engadine
- TIME:** Students must be at school by 8.40 am for roll call and **buses will depart at 8.50am**. The Carnival will finish at 2.30pm and children will return to school for the 3.15pm bell.
- TRAVEL:** All students will travel to the pool by bus. They may return home at the conclusion of the carnival with their parent (or with another parent if they have written permission from their parent) and **ONLY** after the student has been signed out by the transporting parent.
- LUNCH:** Children should bring their lunch as the canteen will only be available at restricted times for drinks, iceblocks and sweets. Hot food will not be available for students.
- WHAT TO WEAR:** All children wear suitable swimmers under their school sports uniform. They must have a sunsafe hat (school or house colour) and sunscreen. A 'rash' shirt for extra sun protection is a great idea for wearing at the pool. Remember the weather can turn cool or wet so include a sweater and an extra towel. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with child's name.
- COST:** \$12. This has been included in the Term 1 combined costs invoice.
- WET WEATHER:** Because there are no other bookings available at the pool it is most unlikely that the carnival will be postponed. If there is heavy rain the carnival will go ahead but only for 50m competitors. Other students will remain at school under teacher supervision. Please check the school website for any updates.
- SPECIAL REQUEST:** The baby pool will be out of bounds all day and the learn to swim pool will only be available at certain times and only under the direct supervision of a teacher
- REMINDER:** All spectators are requested to sit on the grass under the shade shelters. The paved areas at the sides and ends of the pool are for officials and children moving to and from events. This makes good viewing for everyone.
- RECORDS:** On the back of this page you will find a list of the current record holders for our school swimming carnival.
- TIMEKEEPERS NEEDED:** Any parent attending the carnival and willing and able to assist with timekeeping should complete that section on the permission note and return to school as soon as possible.
- PERMISSION NOTE:** All students are required to return to school a completed permission note by Friday 12th February.
